

1 John 5:1

2. Secondly, you must ask Him to come into your heart and your life. You must say a prayer like this and mean it from the bottom of your heart:

“Lord Jesus, I come to You as a sinner, lost and condemned to Hell. I repent of my sins and ask for Your forgiveness. I believe with all my heart that You died on the 5

What Happens When You

Become Born Again?

The Spirit of God will come upon you, and into your heart. Then the inner part of you will be born or produced again.

God gives you a new heart and spirit altogether!

A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.

And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them.

With your new spirit, you become a new man or a new creature. You are ready to live a new life. This new life is possible because you are actually a new person with a new heart.

Chapter 4

What You Must Know

About Water Baptism

1. Baptism comes from the Greek word “baptiso” which means “immersion”. Water baptism is therefore the immersion of a person totally into water. It is not sprinkling or pouring of water.

And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway OUT OF THE WATER:...

Matthew 3:16

And John also was baptizing in Aenon near to Salim, BECAUSE THERE WAS MUCH WATER THERE: and they came, and were baptized.

John 3:23

A lot of water is needed for baptism by immersion.

2. Water baptism is a command to anyone who becomes born again.

And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

3. Water baptism is a direct act of obedience to Christ's instruction.

He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

Mark 16:16

4. Baptism is not for church membership, but an open declaration of our new stand in Christ.

For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

Galatians 3:27

When you are baptized you are openly declaring that you have by faith “put on Christ” so that men may see Christ in you.

5. We identify with the death, burial and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ in baptism.

WHAT YOU MUST KNOW ABOUT WATER BAPTISM

Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

Romans 6:4

The lowering of the convert completely under water pictures Christ's death; the submersion of the convert speaks of His burial and the raising of the convert from the water signifies His resurrection.

Chapter 5

The Baptism of

the Holy Ghost

What is the baptism of the Holy Ghost? The baptism of the Holy Ghost is an experience the believer receives after being born again. It is a promise from God to all those who believe in Jesus Christ.

John the Baptist gave witness of Christ before His baptism that:

I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:

Mathew 3:11

What Happens When a Person Receives the Baptism of the Holy Ghost?

The initial sign that you are baptized with the Holy Ghost is that you speak in tongues.

And when they day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.... And they were filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Acts 2:1-4

And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.

Acts 19:6

Who Can Receive the Baptism of the Holy Ghost?

Anyone who is born again can receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in tongues.

And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; THEY SHALL

SPEAK WITH NEW TONGUES;...

Mark 16:17

How to Receive the Baptism of the Holy Ghost 1. Firstly, you must be born again.

This is the most important qualification.

2. Secondly, you must desire the Holy Spirit.

Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.

Acts 2:38-39

Although it is a promise for every believer, God expects you to desire the gift so that when He pours this blessing on you, it will not go wasted or unused.

But covet earnestly the best gifts;...

1 Corinthians 12:31

...desire spiritual gifts,...

1 Corinthians 14:1

3. Pray and ask God to baptize you with the Holy Ghost.

If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?

Luke 11:13

4. Exercise your faith by speaking out in tongues.

God is not going to put a radio box in your stomach and switch it on and off. He expects you to speak out! You must step out in faith and God will honour that faith.

And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Acts 2:4

Sometimes it is helpful to get a senior Christian to as-sist you by laying hands on you and praying along with you. This can greatly facilitate the process and eliminate doubt and fear.

And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.

Acts 19:6

When you start speaking in tongues for the first time, it may sound like a baby learning to speak – gibberish –

but the Holy Ghost will enable you.

5. Once you start speaking in tongues, don't stop it.

Keep on praying!

The Bible describes the speaking of tongues in two ways. First it is a:

River that flows out of your belly –

In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

John 7:37-39

So let the river flow!!

It is also a:

Stammering tongue-

For with stammering lips and another tongue will he speak to his people.

Isaiah 28:11

Tongues often sound like the voice of a stammerer –

“ba ba ba ba” or “ma ma ma ma”. This is a unique characteristic of the heavenly language.

10 Reasons Why Every Believer Must Speak in Tongues

1. Speaking in tongues is a promise to every believer.

He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; Mark 16:16-17

2. Speaking in tongues helps you to pray according to the will of God.

Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with 23

groanings which cannot be uttered.

Romans 8:26-27

3. Speaking in tongues builds you up to become a strong and powerful Christian.

But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, Jude 1:20

4. Speaking in tongues is talking to God directly in a language only He understands.

For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries.

1 Corinthians 14:2

5. Speaking in tongues gives your spirit the opportunity to pray.

For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful.

1 Corinthians 14:14

6. Speaking in tongues makes your spirit pray best about things concerning you.

Your spirit knows deeper things about yourself than any other part of you.

For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? Even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

1 Corinthians 2:11

Sometimes you may not understand what you are going through in order to pray meaningfully in your nor-mal language. However, you can still pray very effectively in tongues because your spirit knows many things that your mind hasn't yet grasped. Therefore allow your spirit to pray!

7. Speaking in tongues makes you pray for a long time.

You are not limited by language, vocabulary and how to express yourself and so you can pray for a long time.

For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful.

1 Corinthians 14:14

8. Speaking in tongues is a better way to express thanks and appreciation to God.

Else when thou shalt bless with the spirit, how shall he that occupieth the room of the unlearned say Amen at thy giving of thanks, seeing he understandeth not what thou sayest? FOR THOU VERILY GIVEST

THANKS WELL...

1 Corinthians 14:16-17

9. Speaking in tongues makes you more aware of the power of Christ.

You will become bold as you become more and more aware of the power that is at work in the believer. You can stand boldly as a true witness for Jesus. You are fearless in the face of demonic activity and your faith to deal with them is firm.

But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Acts 1:8

10. Speaking in tongues makes you become more conscious of the presence of the Holy Spirit in you as you 26

continue to communicate with God in tongues.

The Holy Spirit is in us to help us. Being more aware of His presence helps you to develop a personal relationship with Him and engage His participation, contribution and influence in our lives.

And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; Even the Spirit of truth; whom

the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

John 14:16-17

The Journey on the Ship

Why should you go to heaven without experiencing all the blessings promised to believers to help our Christian lives here on earth? 3 Things You Must Do with the Word of God 1. Desire The Word

Just as babies survive and grow as they feed on milk daily, born again Christians must survive and grow by daily feeding on the Word of God.

As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby: 1 Peter 2:2

2. You must have a daily quiet time to read the Bible.

This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

Joshua 1:8

Quiet time is a regular daily time you keep with the Lord. It is a personal, unhurried time in Bible reading and praying. Quiet time is a time that God communicates with you through His word and your prayer. In the next Chapter I will share with you seven effective ways to have a quiet time.

3. Be determined to be a doer of the Word.

As a born again Christian, you must fully obey every aspect of the Word of God. You must change your life in accordance to whatever the Bible says.

But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: for he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was. But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

Chapter 8

Seven Steps to an

Effective Quiet Time

Step 1: Pray To Begin Your Quiet Time It's time to give the Lord praise and worship for His goodness. Pray and thank the Lord for another day. Thank Him for who He is, what He has done and what He can and will do. Now ask God to speak to you.

And the Lord passed by before him, and proclaimed, The Lord, The Lord God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers, upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation. And Moses made haste, and bowed his head toward the earth, and worshipped.

Exodus 34:6-8

Step 2: Read A Passage From The Bible Expecting God To Speak To You

Open thou mine eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of thy law.

Psalm 119:18

Read the passage for the day expecting God to speak to you from it. There are several ways of choosing your daily Bible reading passage.

How to Choose a Bible-Reading Passage for Your Quiet Time a. Choose a book from the Bible of which you read a few verses every day. You must always remember where you ended so you can continue from the same place on the next day. In the New Testament, I have had wonderful quiet times as I have read through the books of Luke and Ephesians. In the Old Testament, I have also had wonderful quiet times as I have read through the books of Genesis and 1st and 2nd Samuel.

b. Choose a personality from the Bible whose life story you follow. A few verses from passages about Moses will give you much revelation for your life. You must 34

always remember where you end your reading so that you can start the next day from that point.

c. Take the passage suggested in your daily reading guide.

When I first became a Christian, I depended on “Our Daily Bread” for my quiet time.

Step 3: Meditate (think through and soberly reflect on what you have read)

If you do not think deeply about what you are reading you will lose a major blessing of the Word of God. Paul told Timothy to think about the Word of God.

Consider what I say; and the Lord give thee understanding in all things.

2 Timothy 2:7

7 Keys for Effective Meditation a. Read the passage slowly.

b. Do not read a very long passage unless it is necessary.

c. Stop at any verse that strikes you and think about it.

God's Word is so powerful that only a single word in a verse is enough to change your life. Each quiet time 35

SEVEN STEPS TO AN EFFECTIVE QUIET TIME

There are times that you will need to have a longer quiet time. God may minister to you about something. You must be prepared to study further. This is why it is important to have a good reference Bible.

Look through the passage again for as many of the following as possible:

- i. What does the passage teach me about the nature of God: the Father, the Son, or the Holy Spirit?
- ii. Is there a promise for you to believe, and so claim, taking careful note of any conditions attached?

iii. Is there a command for you to obey, or a good example for you to follow?

iv. Is there a warning to you to heed or a bad example for you to avoid?

v. Is there a prayer for you to pray or remember?

Step 5: Use your Bible reading guide.

You may refer to your daily Bible reading guide.

These Bible reading guides are very helpful in developing a regular quiet time habit. You will benefit from anointed teachers whose ministry will help you to grow.

Step 6: Write down whatever the Lord tells you.

It is important to develop the habit of writing the things that God speaks to you about.

The very fact that you have acquired a notebook shows that you have faith in an invisible God. You believe that He has spoken to you and you have written down His words.

You have taken a great step of faith. Without faith it is not possible to please God.

Step 7: Now spend time praying to the Lord. Listen to the voice of the Holy Spirit.

The last step in your quiet time is to pray. At times you will pray for a short time, but there are other times you will pray for a long time. As you have your quiet time regularly, this prayer time will become longer and longer. You will soon desire longer hours with the Lord.

During the prayer time, God will speak to you through His Spirit. There are things God needs to tell you directly through His Spirit. The Holy Spirit is real and you must believe in Him as well.

To grow in your new life it is important that you do not stay at home without fellowshipping. You must find a Bible-believing church and attend the services regularly.

What Is a Bible-Believing Church?

A Bible-believing church is a church where people are taught to be born again, trained to be effective Christians and the Bible is the only source of truth.

You must support the church financially to help carry the Gospel to others who have not heard and to keep the church work running. God will bless and prosper you as you support His work. Allow Jesus to be Lord over your finances as well.

Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.
